The following code refers to the behaviours expected of players parents at Kingsley Westside FC Juniors Any issues in relation to this code can be addressed to juniorpresident@kingsleywestsidefc.com

Remember that children play sport for their enjoyment – not their parents

Encourage but do not force children to participate

Focus on children's efforts and performance rather than whether they win or lose

Encourage children to play in accordance with the rules and to settle disagreements without hostility or violence

Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a competition

Remember that children learn best through good role modelling Appreciate good performances and skilful plays by all participants

Support all attempts to remove physical and verbal abuse from all sporting activities

Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do the same

Show appreciation for volunteer coaches, officials and administrators
Without them your child could not participate

Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person and positively embrace differences in gender, ability, cultural backgrounds and religions

Spectators are not permitted to stand at the goal ends of the pitch

Please watch from the sidelines and refrain from giving detailed instructions to individual players or your own child

Children learn best on their feet, making their own decisions of play with successes and fails. When in doubt say "I love watching you play"
